

Romans 8:1-17 Prayer Guide

Prayer prompts follow CSB wording & the pattern of the Lord's prayer in Matthew 6:9-13
Remember the ABC's—Be Audible, Brief, & Clear

REVERENCE (“Your name be honored as holy”—Matthew 6:9)

- **Identify and celebrate God’s praiseworthy attributes.**
 - (ie, he no longer condemns us (vs. 1); he sent his Son as a sin offering (vs. 3); he has given us life in the Spirit (vs. 10-11); he has adopted us as his children (vs. 14-17))
- *PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 1-7, 10-11,14-17)*
 - Father, I give thanks to you because...
 - Father, I praise you for...

RESPONSE (“Your kingdom come, your will be done...”—Matthew 6:10-11a)

- **Identify areas of your life that need to be reoriented to God and his ways.**
- *PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 1, 5-9)*
 - Father, help me remember that there is no condemnation for me even though...
 - Father, I confess that I’m prone to have my mind set on the flesh when...
 - Father, help me set my mind on (the things of the Spirit, ie, life and peace) when...

REQUESTS (“Give us....and forgive us...”—Matthew 6:11b-12)

- **Ask the Spirit to guide your prayer over concerns, relationships, and resources**
- *PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 1-3, 14-17)*
 - Father, please set (person) free from the power of sin and death and adopt him/her as your child through faith in Jesus.
 - Father, please help (person) cry out to you as he/she goes through...
 - Father, please help me remember that I have inherited you even as I need...
 - Father, please help me/person remember that glory is coming even as I/he/she go(es) through...

READINESS (“Do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us...”—Matthew 6:13)

- **Encouragement and strength for the spiritual battle**
- *PRAYER PROMPTS (From vs. 12–14)*
 - Father, help me put ____ to death by the power of the Spirit as I...
 - Father, please lead me/us by your Spirit as I/we...
- *Group response after each prayer: “There is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus.”*
